Procedures to be followed to obtained the product/service	• The Fund sender will pay the amount to be remitted to the Foreign Exchange Agent/ House with the details of beneficiary Full Name, Sender Name, Remitted Amount and Person Identification Document Number (NIC/DL/PP – not mandatory) and remitter will be given a Reference Number to the beneficiary.
	The Beneficiary will visit the nearest branch and fill the CDB Money Remittance Form with MTC Number.
	Release the funds to beneficiary after verifying the beneficiary with the system entered details and
	Identification document.
Terms and Conditions	To ensure the security of the service, will not release money to a third party.
	Required Documents
	- National Identity Card/ Driving License or the Valid Passport
	- Money Transfer Control Number (MTCN)
	- Sender's Details (Full Name/ Country/ Amount Transferred)

	Exchange foreign currency as per the given rate
Terms and Conditions	 Following documents are required to sell foreign currencies based on scenarios. Foreign Currency Selling For Travel Abroad - Valid Passport with Valid NIC/ Driving License, Valid Visa and a Return Air Ticket Passport will be endorsed by authorized officer in CDB Foreign Currency Buying - Should provide a valid National Identity Card/ Driving License/ Passport
