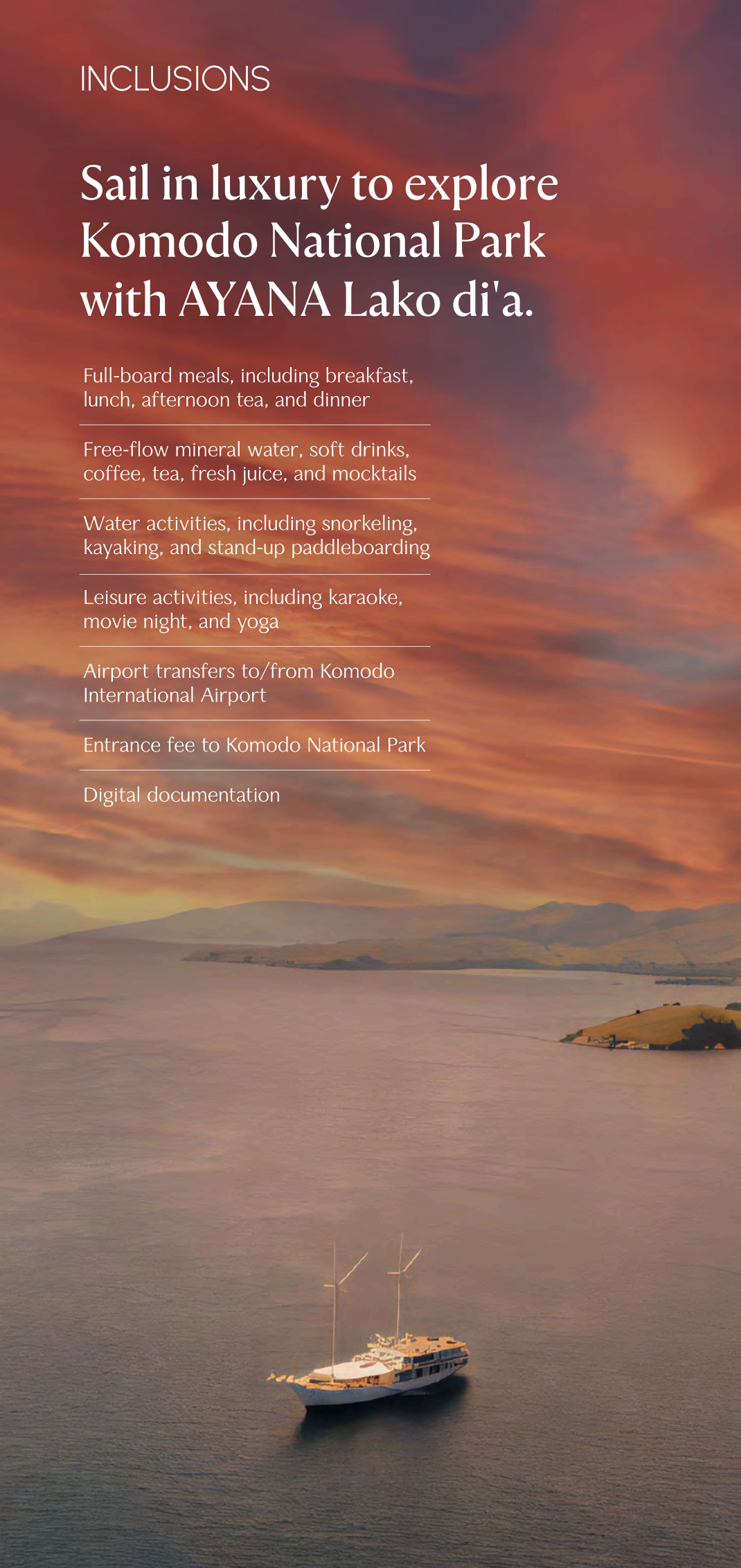

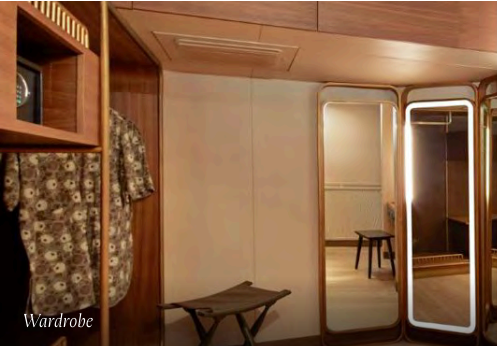

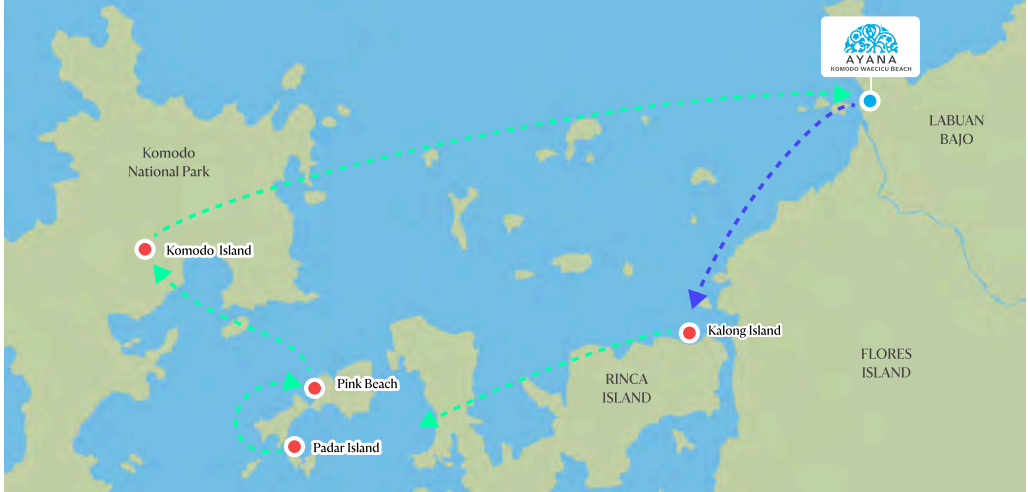

Day 2: Komodo Island - Pink Beach - Padar Island

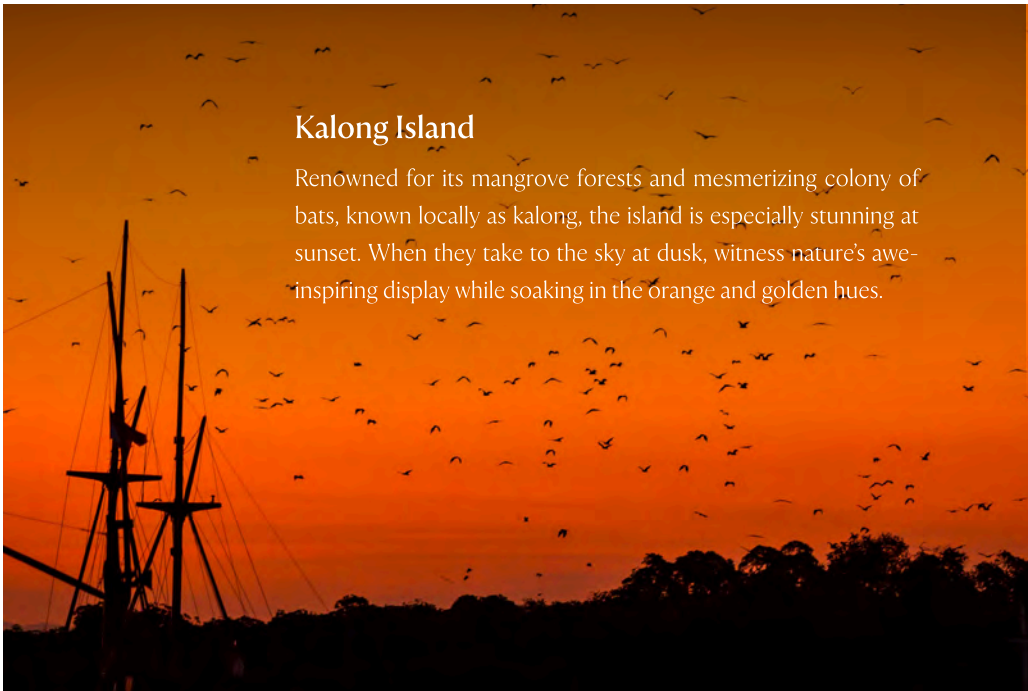
Day 3: Taka Makassar - Manta Point - Siaba Island - AYANA Komodo



DESTINATIONS

Kalong Island

Renowned for its mangrove forests and mesmerizing colony of bats, known locally as kalong, the island is especially stunning at sunset. When they take to the sky at dusk, witness nature's awe-inspiring display while soaking in the orange and golden hues.

Padar Island

Hiking to the summit of Padar Island takes approximately 1 hour and 30 minutes, but the effort is well worth it as it rewards you with a breathtaking panoramic view of the surrounding landscape. From the highest peak, you can take in a stunning vantage point of four shimmering crescent-shaped beaches, which provide ample opportunities for capturing Instagrammable shots in every direction.



Pink Beach

This one-of-a-kind beach gets its striking color from a microscopic creature, Foraminifera, which produces a red pigment on the fringing coral reefs. When combined with degraded red coral, it creates a dazzling dusty pink color. Beneath the turquoise waters you will find thousands of colorful fish as well graceful sea turtles.



Komodo Island

Komodo Island is home to the largest lizard on earth, the iconic Komodo dragon, which has lived in Flores for over 1 million years. Professional rangers guide guests around the park to give you a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity to photograph the dragons in their natural habitat. The island also offers great trekking options, enabling you to experience its unique biodiversity and encounter other animals, such as water buffaloes, exotic birds, boars and deer.
