- History
- Wisdom and Writings
- Prophets

New Testament : 27 books

- Gospels and History
- Letters (including Apocalypse)

What does GBC believe about the Scripture?

The Bible was written by men divinely inspired and is God's revelation of Himself to man. It is a perfect treasure of divine instruction. It has God for its author, salvation for its end, and truth, without any mixture of error, for its matter. Therefore, all Scripture is totally true and trustworthy. It reveals the principles by which God judges us, and therefore is, and will remain to the end of the world, the true center of Christian union, and the supreme

standard by which all human conduct, creeds, and religious opinions should be tried. All Scripture is a testimony to Christ, who is Himself the focus of divine revelation.

What are the attributes of the Scripture?

All Scripture is breathed out by God and profitable for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, that the man of God may be complete, equipped for every good work.

- Inspired by God
 - o <u>Infallible</u>: trustworthy, incapable of error, will not fail
 - o **Inerrant**: free from error
- Written by <u>humans</u>
