In the bedroom, raw finishes continue, reinforcing the home's design identity. Yet what stands out is a playful yet practical touch—a bespoke glass block bedside table, repurposed from leftover materials. "We love creating meaningful connections with our clients," says Ken. "They were open to trying something custom, which made the end result much more personal."

What are the consumer safeguards offered by a CaseTrust-Accredited Renovation Business?

CaseTrust-accredited renovation businesses are required to provide three key safety nets for consumers:

1. Standard Renovation

Contract – Contractors must adopt the CaseTrust Standard Renovation Contract that clearly outlines the scope of work, payment schedules, and project timelines. This ensures each party's obligations, and the project deliverables are spelt out. The standard contract also covers consumers with a workmanship warranty for a period of 12 months from completion date of the renovation work.

2. Deposit Protection

Insurance – Contractors are required to purchase the Deposit Performance Bond that safeguards consumers' deposits in the event of sudden business closure. This measure provides financial security and peace of mind for homeowners engaging renovation services.

3. Structured Dispute Resolution Process –

the unknown dangers of formaldehyde

WHY IS FORMALDEHYDE A CAUSE FOR CONCERN AFTER YOU RENOVATE, AND HOW DO YOU PROTECT YOUR HOME FROM ITS HARMFUL EFFECTS?



The topic of formaldehyde has been buzzing for the last quarter of 2024, after several news reports of people falling sick due to the high levels of this VOC chemical found in their homes. One homeowner, as reported in an article in The Straits Times, had to be hospitalised because of respiratory issues after her renovation, and had to renovate again just to clear her home of formaldehyde.



What is formaldehyde?

Formaldehyde is a volatile organic compound (VOC) or colourless gas pollutant released by furniture and wooden products containing formaldehyde-based resins. It is usually found in fibreboards, insulating materials, paint, wallpaper, varnishes, and household cleaning products. As it is 500 times smaller than 0.1 microns, formaldehyde is hard to detect. It has been reported that it can continue to off-gas between three to 15 years.



How does offgassing occur?

Off-gassing is the airborne release of a chemical in vapour form. Simply put, whenever you smell a product, it's off-gassing. It happens the most when the product is new. The scary part is that many products and materials continue off-gassing even after the 'new smell' disappears. The fumes are just less subtle.

How can exposure to formaldehyde cause harm?

It has been widely reported by World Health Organisation and other research bodies that while most indoor formaldehyde readings at any given time may appear low, continuous exposure through offgassing can still occur over multiple years. This is particularly relevant for recently renovated homes. Common negative reactions to formaldehyde include respiratory issues, eye irritation, skin reactions, headache, dizziness, and even longer-term chronic health problems.



Hiring an interior designer who is well-informed of the risks of formaldehyde can help ensure lower emissions after renovation. Designers can take on an advisory role to encourage clients and ensure their newly renovated space has plenty of fresh air intake and circulation before moving in. Here are more tips to help you take better preventative measures:



#1 Ask vendors for their most low-VOC or PVC-free product options

#2 Ventilate by regularly opening windows or turning on powerful air purifiers with activated carbon filters and HEPA filters.

#3 Use dehumidifiers or air-conditioners to lower the humidity levels. Having a lower level of humidity can cut down off-gassing.










In paint, the addition of VOCs allows paint to glide smoothly onto a surface. Since most rooms in homes are painted, VOCs are probably everywhere. That said, VOCs in paint can off-gas fumes for weeks, months, or years, after the initial application. The adverse health effects of VOCs are therefore convincing more and more homeowners to consider less toxic paint products.



What are low or zero-VOC paints?

By reading the paint tin can label, it will indicate if the low VOC paint contains less than 50 grams of volatile organic compounds per litre. Zero VOC paints must contain less than five grams of these compounds per litre. Even with no or low VOCs, some paints may still contain other harmful chemicals, especially if a colour has been added into it.



Appearance

Standard paints are formulated to make painting tasks easy and only one or two coats are all you need. You'll find the formula goes on smoothly and evenly, all thanks to VOCs making coverage easy. On the other hand, low or zero-VOC paints can attain that smooth coverage, but you'll probably need a few more applications to get that perfect finish.

Durability

Standard VOC paints are most durable because of their washability, opacity, and scuff resistance attributes. With more awareness given to green products, low or zero-VOC paints are slowly becoming more resilient, with more testing done to meet durability factors such as adhesion, applicability, scrubbability, and washability.







Marcus Ng from Lian Hin Pte Ltd notes the changes in consumer behavior: "Instagram and Pinterest have raised the bar for design, increasing consumer demands for visually appealing environments."

Vincent Neo from Weiken.com Interior Design points out the shift to digital interactions: "Business now primarily happens online, making the process more accessible and transparent." Similarly, Justin Ong of Azora Private Limited highlights the role of social platforms: "They are crucial for showcasing work and for homeowners to gather inspiration and reviews."

Define successful urban living in Singapore.

Vincent (Starry Homestead) advocates for designs that resonate personally rather than merely following trends, stating, "True success in design comes from creating spaces that feel like a personal haven."

Marcus (Lian Hin) underscores the importance of balance in urban living, focusing on "combining comfort, functionality, and sustainability to enhance daily life without compromising environmental responsibility."

These insights collectively reflect a shift toward creating more thoughtful, personalised living environments that cater to the evolving needs of urban dwellers.

What is lacking or underdeveloped in the renovation industry?

Kelvin Lim from Vegas Interior Design Pte Ltd highlights several areas needing development in Singapore's renovation industry: "Strict regulatory frameworks, whilst ensuring safety, often restrict creative freedom and slow innovation. High labour costs and scarcity of specialised materials limit design possibilities. Additionally, reliance on outdated manual processes hinders efficiency compared to markets using advanced design software like BIM or VR."

Lim Ah Bah from Sin Lee Hong Pte Ltd discusses the tough market dynamics, explaining, "Renovation providers must balance high consumer expectations and price sensitivity whilst navigating high operational costs." He emphasises that, "Consumers

demand top-notch craftsmanship and innovative designs but are also highly pricesensitive, often seeking the best deals."

Eric Lim from Eight Design Pte Ltd adds, "The local renovation industry faces insufficient transparency, accountability, and limited adoption of modern technology. Homeowners often experience unforeseen costs, delays, and unprofessional practices. To restore trust, clearer regulations, digital project tracking, and stringent contractor vetting supported by verified reviews are essential."

Will wellness-centered renovations emerge as a predominant trend shortly?

Marcus (Lian Hin Pte Ltd) elaborates on the necessity of wellness in design, "Wellness-centred design is a growing necessity... homeowners are prioritising natural light, nature elements, and ergonomic setups." This reflects a deeper integration of health and wellbeing into living spaces.

Vincent (Starry Homestead) reinforces this trend, "Wellness has always been a cornerstone in my design philosophy... a well-designed home naturally improves mood and provides renewal." His approach signifies a holistic view where design impacts overall life quality.

Mary Mark from Wing Khiong Renovation and Trading indicates a broadening focus towards societal benefits and wellness in communal spaces. She says: "We have ventured more into community projects... providing society with a better quality spatial experience."

BEFORE RENOVATION

Awaken the Marie Kondo in you

Make space for new and good things in life! Clear out old and unused items periodically. Do not leave bulky items in common areas, as they obstruct walkways (especially for pram and mobility-aid users), block emergency escape routes, and are potential fire hazards.

What to do with bulky items?

If you have bulky household items and old furniture, such as bed frames and sofas, to discard, contact your Town Council to arrange for collection and disposal. This service is free for up to three bulky items per month (please check with your Town Council for more details).



Keep noise levels down

Renovation works can be loud and disturbing, so it is important to spare a thought for your neighbours, especially those who may be studying or working from home. As a rule of thumb, noisy renovation works (such as hacking of walls and heavy drilling) can only be done from 9am to 5pm from Monday to Friday, excluding public holidays and eve of major public holidays (such as New Year's Day, Chinese New Year, Deepavali, Hari Raya Puasa and Christmas Day).

What to do with renovation debris?

For any renovation debris, ensure that your renovation contractor disposes of them appropriately at a National Environment Agency (NEA)-approved site.



SPOT IT? REPORT IT!

If you see items being indiscriminately discarded in common areas, you can report it via the Municipal Services Office's OneService app. Note that Town Councils can take action against errant parties for illegal dumping.














a guide to renovating your HDB flat

Congratulations on receiving the keys to your new home! As you step inside, you're probably imagining how to shape your new space into a true reflection of your style and needs. Before you get started, take a moment to familiarise yourself with this handy renovation guide to help you transform your flat into the perfect haven you've always dreamed of.

1. Engage a Contractor listed in the Directory of Renovation Contractors (DRC)

When engaging a renovation contractor, it is important to engage only those listed in the DRC. This also applies to renovations which do not require HDB's prior approval.

The DRC lists contractors who are familiar with HDB renovation guidelines, rules and requirements which are in place to protect the structural integrity of the building. You can view the DRC (https://go.gov.sg/hdb-reno-contractors) on HDB InfoWEB, or via the Mobile@HDB app.

That said, HDB does not endorse or guarantee the quality of the renovations. The DRC-listed contractor will be fully responsible for the contractual responsibilities towards you, their client, including workmanship.



2. Submit a Renovation Application

You and your DRC-listed contractor must obtain HDB's prior approval before starting any demolishing and/ or hacking of walls, whether partially or fully. This mandatory requirement protects residents' safety, as unauthorised demolishing and/ or hacking of walls may affect the structural integrity of the building.

For renovations works that require HDB's prior approval, ensure that your DRC-listed contractor submits an online renovation application to HDB together with the acknowledgement form signed by you, the flat owner, before commencing work.

You will receive a Short Message Service (SMS) notification upon the submission of the renovation application by your DRC-listed contractor. To view the status of your renovation permit application, log in to My HDBPage on HDB InfoWEB (www.hdb.gov.sg).

You can also read up online at the HDB InfoWEB on HDB renovation permits as well as guidelines and important information for gas and water works that can be done in your flat.

3. Contact Other Agencies on Related Works

During the renovation process, you will most likely require other services such as air-conditioner installation.

If you plan to mount your airconditioner on the exterior of your flat, or if any part of the airconditioner will project from your flat, you must engage a BCA-trained air-conditioner installer. Once the air conditioning unit has been installed, you will also need to email the installation report to the HDB Branch managing your flat.

Check out the list of other works below to find out if a licensed worker/contractor is required:

TYPES OF WORK THAT REQUIRE A	LICENSED WORKER OR CONTRACTOR	
Water services and sanitary works	Plumber licensed by the Public Utilities Board (PUB)	
Gas service works	Gas service worker licensed by the Energy Market Authority (EMA)	
Window works	Window contractor approved by the Building and Construction Authority (BCA) and listed with HDB	
Electrical works	Electrical worker licensed by the Energy Market Authority (EMA)	

4. Keep Renovations to Permitted Hours

Noise from renovation works can be disruptive to your neighbours, especially those who have young children, or are working from home. Here are easy ways to maintain harmonious relations with our neighbours:

- Inform your neighbours staying within a radius of 2 units at least 5 days before renovations begin. Do remind your DRC-listed contractor to put up the Notice of Renovation outside your flat early and throughout the renovation period.
- · As part of the HDB renovation guidelines, only carry out renovations between the stipulated timings below:

TYPE OF WORKS	ALLOWED ON	X NOT ALLOWED ON
General Renovation e.g. Plastering, painting, and laying of floor screed	Monday — Saturday 9am — 6pm	Sundays and Public Holidays
Restricted Renovation e.g. Demolishing of walls, removing of wall/ floor finishes, and cutting of tiles	Monday — Friday 9am — 5pm	Saturdays, Sundays, all Public Holidays, and the eves of: New Year's Day Chinese New Year Deepavali Hari Raya Puasa Christmas Day

- If you plan to carry out DIY (Do-It-Yourself) works, do limit it between 7:00am and 10:30pm, and keep noise to a minimum.
- When possible, close the main door of your flat while works are ongoing, to help reduce noise disturbance to your neighbours and do remember to inform them in advance of any works that may generate noise.

5. Manage Payment and Any Renovations Dispute

The renovation contract between flat owners and their DRC-listed contractors is a private one, and not regulated by any government agency. If there are disputes over the renovation such as pricing, costs, work schedule, type, or quality of renovations, these should be resolved between both parties.

If you are facing challenges with settling the matter amicably, both parties may approach the Consumers Association of Singapore (CASE), Singapore Mediation Centre or the Small Claims Tribunals for assistance or seek legal redress.

6. Use the Lifts Properly


Renovating and moving into your new home is an exciting time for all home owners! However, it can also be hectic, dusty, and noisy. Movers and contractors carrying bulky items will be a common sight, and lifts may take a slightly longer time to arrive.

Remind your contractors or vendors avoid jamming the lift doors when moving materials and furniture as this can damage the lifts, causing inconvenience and delay to other lift users.

7. Keep your Neighbourhood Clean

Unwanted items such as packing materials and renovation debris discarded around your estate can potentially create safety and health hazards and will mar the image of your estate.

Do remind your delivery persons, movers, and contractors to dispose of renovation debris and unwanted items properly by carting them to disposal sites. They should not wash or flush debris into the sewage system or dispose of bulky items into the refuse chute, as this could cause damage and inconvenience you and your neighbours.



You may report instances of lift misuse and dumping of debris in the common areas via the OneService website (https://go.gov.sg/oneservice) or app.

8. Care for Your Home Regularly

Finally, it's important to carry out regular checks on the fittings and fixtures in your home. This can help you spot areas that require attention before they become serious and save you money on major repairs.

minimum occupation period

The MOP policy safeguards HDB flats for households with genuine housing needs and helps to deter speculative purchase of HDB flats.

HDB flat owners are required to fulfil a MOP before selling or renting out their flat or buying other residential properties. This means that owners must physically occupy their flat during the MOP.

If the flat owners fail to live in their flats during the MOP, without exceptional approval by HDB, HDB will take action, including compulsorily acquiring the flats.

JUST FACTS

HDB flats are primarily for owner-occupation, and HDB is committed to upholding the Minimum Occupation Period (MOP) policy.



We follow up with every feedback received.

This includes inspecting the subject unit, conducting interviews with the flat owners/ buyers/ neighbours, and reviewing other supporting evidence or records indicating flat occupation.



We conduct an inspection for every HDB flat that is undergoing a resale transaction, which also allows us to identify if the flat was lived in.

If there are signs that the flat has not been lived in, **HDB will** withhold the resale application and commence investigations.

don't get caught unprepared when you face home maintenance issues!

Did you know that flat owners are responsible for maintaining their own homes? This includes the fittings and fixtures, as well as the overall condition of the flat, to ensure a safe and pleasant environment for themselves. This is why you need to know how to keep your flat in good condition, and what to do when you face a breakdown. Here are some tips to guide you along!

Fixtures and fittings in a home, especially those with moving parts and hinges, will experience wear and tear over time.

When they break down, the resulting inconvenience and safety concerns can be stressful.

The good news is that it is possible to prevent sudden breakdowns through regular maintenance. Keeping your flat in good condition also helps you avoid costly repairs in future. The routine maintenance in your flat will go a long way towards an optimal living environment for you and your family.

If it happens...

If – and when – the inevitable happens, engage a repair contractor or ask your friends and family members for recommendations for a reliable handyman service. You may even carry out the maintenance on your own if you know how!

Read on to find out what you can do to maintain your flat in a liveable condition, and where to seek handyman services if you need one.

As a general guide, you should:

- Replace worn parts early
- Keep the rooms wellventilated to prevent wall cracks that may result from the expansion and contraction of the materials from temperature changes
- Disconnect any unnecessary appliances and avoid overloading power sockets
- Check the windows regularly to ensure that they are in good condition at all times
- Install a sink strainer to prevent solids from clogging up the sink



Spalling concrete

This issue is often found in damp areas of older flats (kitchen, toilet). This natural deterioration process causes concrete to bulge, crack or even dislodge — look out for these signs on your ceilings.

I think there is spalling concrete on my ceiling. What should I do?

- Engage a contractor to repair the area it is the homeowner's responsibility to do so
- Cover your floor and furniture in the affected area with thick cardboard
- Remove loose spalling concrete as they may dislodge and cause injury
- Wear protective gloves
- Dispose loosened concrete at the centralised bin area of your estate

What do I do to prevent spalling concrete?

- Ventilate the damp areas of your flat (e.g. keep the windows and doors open)
- · Paint ceilings regularly
- Treat cracked areas with sealant

What are the signs that my sliding windows require maintenance work?

- Safety stoppers are missing or worn out
- Missing angle strips

Check that the safety stoppers and angle strips are in their proper places

Sliding window

Clean the tracks and ensure that window panels can slide smoothly

Change worn-out safety stoppers and angle strips by engaging a BCA-approved window contractor listed with HDB

What are the signs that my **casement windows** require maintenance work?

- Fasteners are made of aluminium, and are rusty or loose
- Moving parts are deformed or stiff

Check that fasteners are not rusty or loose
Clean and oil joints or moving parts
Change all rivets from aluminium to stainless steel by
engaging a BCA-approved window contractor listed with HDB

What are the signs that my **louvred windows** require maintenance work?

- Broken or cracked glass panes
- · Jammed adjustable lever, if any

Window safety

It is every homeowner's responsibility to ensure that the flat's windows are properly maintained. If any is damaged, engage a Building and Construction Authority (BCA)-approved window contractor listed with HDB to repair it; at the same time, take immediate action

Ceiling leaks are common due to wear and tear.



Falling windows are a serious safety risk.

Should windows fall due to a lack of maintenance, homeowners may face a fine of up to \$10,000 and/or a jail term of up to one year.

Flat owners are responsible for the maintenance of their own homes.

KEEPING YOUR HOME IN IP-TOP SHAPE THE DIY WAY!

HERE ARE SOME TIPS AND TRICKS TO MAINTAIN YOUR HOME.

Home maintenance and upkeep is vital to ensure you have a safe and pleasant place to live, and this begins the moment you receive the keys to your flat.

As the flat owner, you are responsible for the maintenance of your own home! Here are some minor maintenance works that can be easily carried out on a DIY basis. Check out the following pointers.

Paint peeling and mouldy ceiling

Mould growth and paint peeling issues in HDB are generally related to moisture and humidity in the flat; at times, they are due to improper surface preparation before the coating of new paint.

What to do?

- Allow cross-ventilation in the flat. Keep windows, vents or doors open as often as possible.
- Check the ceiling to ensure that any holes or cracks are sealed to prevent moisture from entering.
- Repaint the ceiling regularly. If necessary, engage a competent contractor to do the job.

Floor traps

Your bathroom or kitchen floor trap may develop a foul smell, or have water overflowing from it due to clogging.

What to do?

- Remove solid materials that are causing the floor trap to choke.
 In severe cases, you may need to seek the help of a licensed plumber.
- Close the floor trap grating to prevent particles, such as hair, from clogging it.
- Avoid pouring cooking oil down the floor trap as it may solidify and cause the floor trap to choke.
- Use a diluted solution of one part bleach to 99 parts water to clean your bathroom and kitchen regularly.

Floor finishes

Refinishing or repairing your floor can be costly and inconvenient, which is why it is advisable to prolong the life of your flooring as much as possible.

What to do?

- Use a stiff brush or old toothbrush to loosen grout and reinstate joints with suitable tile grout.
- Install rubber soles or paddings to legs of movable furniture to reduce damage to your floor.



Bathroom fittings

Everyone uses their bathroom multiple times each day, which makes it even more important to keep it in good condition.

What to do?

- Keep your bathroom door and door frame dry by installing shower screens or curtains at the shower area, ventilating the bathroom properly after showering, and wiping the door and door frame dry if they get wet.
- Replace your shower screen door sealant when it turns yellowish or black, and/or if water begins to leak through its joints.
- Clean bathroom fittings, such as basin taps, with a mild detergent to prevent corrosion.

MINIMISE NOISE WHEN YOU RENOVATE

With work-from-home becoming increasingly common, it is always good to show consideration to your neighbours, who may be working from home, by keeping noise disturbances to a minimum. Take note of the following to make your renovation journey a pleasant one for everyone:

- General renovation works that do not involve loud noises, such as painting or plastering, can be carried out from Monday to Saturday, 9am to 6pm.
- Noisy works that require excessive hacking and drilling must be limited to Monday to Friday, 9am to 5pm. They cannot be carried out on Saturdays, Sundays, public holidays, and the eve of New Year's Day, Chinese New Year, Hari Raya Puasa, Deepavali and Christmas.
- Simple DIY reno works, such as installing of lights and shelves, can occur outside of the above-mentioned time frames. However, you should limit such works to between 7am and 10.30pm, and keep noise levels to a minimum. One way to do that is to keep your main door closed and inform your neighbours in advance.
 - Download the Municipal Services Office's OneService
 App to get information, such as duration of
 renovations taking place in your block, via the Home
 Renovation Notice (HRN) this can help you plan your
 at-home activities ahead of time.
 - Works that do not affect the structure of the building do not require a renovation permit and thus neighbouring units will not be notified via the OneService App. However, it is still a good practice to be considerate and keep your neighbours informed of these works, so they can make their own arrangements.

Wall cracks

A result of natural expansion and contraction, wall cracks are a common occurrence in many homes.

What to do?

- Repaint the wall with a flexible sealant or elastomeric paint to seal hairline cracks.
- Engage an approved contractor to repair wider cracks.


