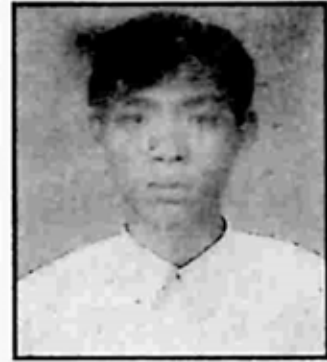

Some Fruits I Like

These fried bananas are eaten with sugar. Banana is one of the fruits in dessert. At the beginning and end of the Buddhist Lent, Myanmar people make glutinous rice flakes (*moun-zan*) and eat with bananas and sugar. Banana can also be made into juice and be drunk. Banana can give us sweet taste and many nutritive values but it also has side-effects. It can make phlegm in the pharynx and can cause coughing. Orange has sour taste. Orange can only get in winter and only grow in cool parts of the country. Orange juice can make me fresh.

The three fruits mentioned above are my favourite ones. Each can give me each different tastes and different effects. But I can only eat banana every season since mangoes and oranges are seasonable fruits. These can make me to have a fresh complexion. I always eat one of these fruits after meal.
