Project Concept:

The SEADOM Student Project is a part of the SEADOM Congress and provides a challenging opportunity and venue for students from SEADOM member schools to get together for a musical experience and friendship.

Last year in Vientiane, Lao PDR, a group of 12 SEA students joined with 8 Laotian to create a 15 minutes creative work that featured improvisational elements, traditional and modern instruments, and beyond that a building of friendships.
