

YOUR HOTLOTZ AUCTION INVOICE EXPLAINED

This explainer illustrates how we have prepared an invoice for an item sold in an auction. The item, a teak planter's chair, had a closing bid of \$400.00 inc. GST and was subject to a buyer's premium fee of 24% inc. GST.

1. Your registered account name and unique Hotlotz reference

Please ensure that your Hotlotz account is registered in your full legal name and pay your own invoices.

This is important as Hotlotz can only accept payments from the buyer named on the invoice. We cannot accept third-party payments from an individual or organisation that is not named as the buyer. This includes payments from a spouse or another family member.

If you need to make any changes to your personal details, it's easy to do at any time in your Hotlotz account.

Your unique Hotlotz reference (sometimes referred to as your paddle number) is also listed here. You should quote this if you contact us with any general queries about your account.

2. Your unique invoice number for handy reference

The invoice number shown here relates to this specific invoice. You should quote it if you contact us with any queries about this invoice.

If you pay your invoice by bank transfer or PayNow, please quote this invoice number as the reference.

3. Your invoice reference

The reference shown here is the name of the specific auction that the items on your invoice were sold in.

4. This line item shows the closing bid amount (referred to as the 'hammer price')

The description additionally shows the lot number and title which this relates to.

5. This line item shows the buyer's premium fee

The description additionally shows the lot number and title which this relates to.

The buyer's premium fee we charge you is calculated on each item as 24% of the closing bid price achieved in auction.

6. This shows the total GST you have paid for all taxable supplies at the prevailing rate including commission and fees.

In line with price display rules in Singapore, closing bid prices and buyer's premium fees are inclusive of GST. This shows the total GST that you have paid.

7. This shows the outstanding amount

Please make immediate payment for the full amount shown. If your invoice is paid this will show zero, thanks for paying promptly!
