



MR. DAMMIKA NANAYAKKARA



Mr. Nanayakkara currently serves as the Deputy CEO (Operations) at LTL Holdings (Pvt) Ltd (LTLH), where he has contributed over three decades of distinguished services to electrical power industry. After graduating with First Class Honours in Electrical Engineering from the University of Moratuwa in 1995, he steadily rose through the ranks at LTLH, holding key roles including Design Engineer, Engineering Manager, Chief Technology Officer, and now a pivotal leadership position within the Group.

Throughout his career, Mr. Nanayakkara has overseen the design, engineering, and EPC execution of a wide spectrum of energy infrastructure—from thermal, wind, hydro, and solar power plants to high-voltage grid substations and energy-saving innovations. Notably, he served as Chief Project Manager of the landmark 300 MW Combined Cycle Power Plant in Kerawalapitiya, valued at over USD 300 million, and led the Group's overseas power plant portfolio of over 900 MW with a total project value exceeding USD 1.2 billion.

Currently, he is spearheading the 350 MW LNG Power Plant in Kerawalapitiya—an essential part of Sri Lanka's future energy mix. His track record also includes innovations in lightning protection systems, self-protected transformers, and industrial energy-saving projects, underscoring his commitment to technological advancement and energy efficiency.

Mr. Nanayakkara holds a Master of Engineering degree from the University of Moratuwa and is a Chartered Electrical Engineer (CEng) and Chartered Professional Engineer (CPEng), registered with the Engineering Councils of Sri Lanka, the UK, and Australia. He is also a Fellow of the Institution of Engineers, Sri Lanka; a Fellow of the Institution of Engineering and Technology (UK); a Senior Member of the IEEE (USA); and a Member of Engineers Australia.
