Professor Rahula Attalage is the Pro Vice Chancellor Academic and Professor in Mechanical Engineering at the Sri Lanka Institute of Information Technology (SLIIT). He is Professor Emeritus University of Moratuwa and the former Deputy Vice Chancellor of University of Moartuwa. He obtained his Ph.D. from Ecole Nationale Supérieure des Mines, Paris in Energy Engineering in 1992.

He is a Chartered Engineer of the Institution of Engineers Sri Lanka, Corporate Member and a past President of Sri Lanka Energy Managers Association, Member of the Sri Lanka Association for Advancement of Science (SLAAS), Fellow National Academy of Sciences Sri Lanka.

He has served as a visiting faculty member of AIT, Thailand and as a Visiting Professor at Toyohashi University of Technology in Japan and been involved in the higher education and research for the past 35 years. His research areas are Building Energy systems, Renewable energy systems, Industrial energy systems and solar thermal systems. He has also been involved in many industry related projects and more specifically currently in the area of Green Buildings in Sri Lanka, Bangladesh and Pakistan.

He has received the Presidential Award for Research several times and also decorated by the Order of Academic Palms of the Government of France.

He has also held the posts of member of the commission of the Public Utilities Commission of Sri Lanka, Chairman National Institute of Fisheries and Nautical Engineering, Member of the Board of Directors National Engineering Research & Development Center and member of many committees on developing energy performance standards. He currently hold the posts of Commission Member to the UGC, Board Member to the UDA and Member to the Board of Governors to the Sir Arthur C Clark Institute for Modern Technology.
