Release Summary

Access UBS Payroll Evo – SOCSO SKBBK Flag Patch

This release provides a one-off patch programme to resolve an issue in Access UBS Payroll Evo v2026.3 where the new Contribute to SKBBK checkbox is not defaulted to ticked for existing employees after upgrade. The patch ticks the flag for any employee whose Contribute to SKBBK has not yet been saved, so that SKBBK (Lindung 24 Jam / Non-Occupational Accident Scheme) contribution is correctly calculated during Process Pay — in line with PERKESO's Lindung 24 Jam Scheme effective 1 June 2026.

Important Note:

- You might need to disable your Anti-virus before you install the new update as some Anti-virus can interfere and prevent a successful installation.

SOC SO SKBBK Flag Patch

About

What is happening?

With compliance to the Employees' Social Security (Amendment) Act 2026 (Act A1788), effective from 1 June 2026, employees covered under Act 4 (SOC SO Category 1 or 2) are required to contribute to the Lindung 24 Jam Scheme / Non-Occupational Accident Scheme (SKBBK).

In Access UBS Payroll v2026.3, a new Contribute to SKBBK checkbox was introduced at employee level (Statutory Info → SOC SO Info section) to control SKBBK contribution per employee. However, there was an issue in v2026.3 where the Contribute to SKBBK checkbox remained unticked for existing employees after the upgrade, causes inconveniences to the users. Newly created employees are not affected.

Who is affected?

Customers who have upgraded to Access UBS Payroll v2026.3 before 11:00 AM, 15 June 2026 with existing employee records in their company database.

What is affected?

For the affected employees ONLY:

- The Contribute to SKBBK checkbox is unticked by default after upgrade, so users have to manually configure the flag one by one for all eligible employees prior to Process Pay.

Will we see any change?

An external program 'SOC SO SKBBK Flag Patch' has been developed:

- To enable the Contribute to SKBBK checkbox (set to ticked) for employees whose flag has not yet been saved, in one click.
- To allow SKBBK contribution to be calculated correctly during the next Process Pay.

What could user do?

- Run the external programme 'SKBBK Flag Patch' to enable the Contribute to SKBBK flag for employees whose flag has not yet been saved.
- After running the patch, manually untick Contribute to SKBBK only for specific employees who fall under PERKESO Scenarios 26/27 (employee has more than one employer and has chosen another employer to deduct SKBBK).
- If necessary, re-run Process Pay for June 2026 (or the affected pay period) so that SKBBK contribution is correctly calculated for the affected employees.

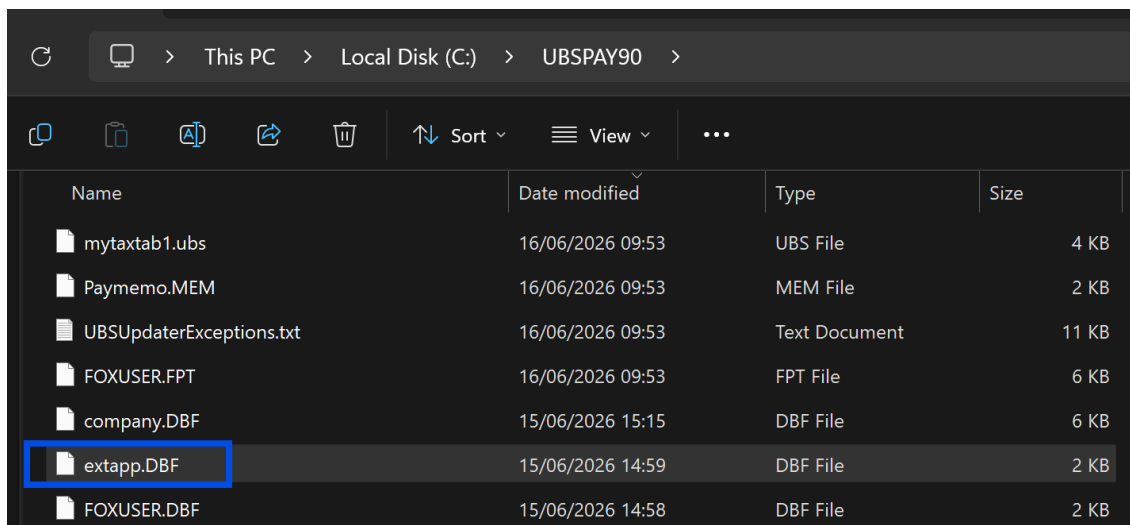

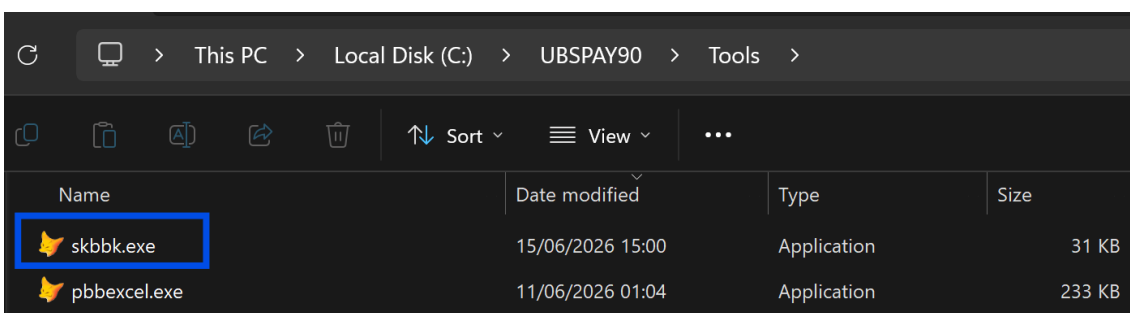

2. After extracting the zip file, copy **extapp.DBF** to **C:\UBSPAY90** folder and **skbbk.exe** to **C:\UBSPAY90\Tools** folder.

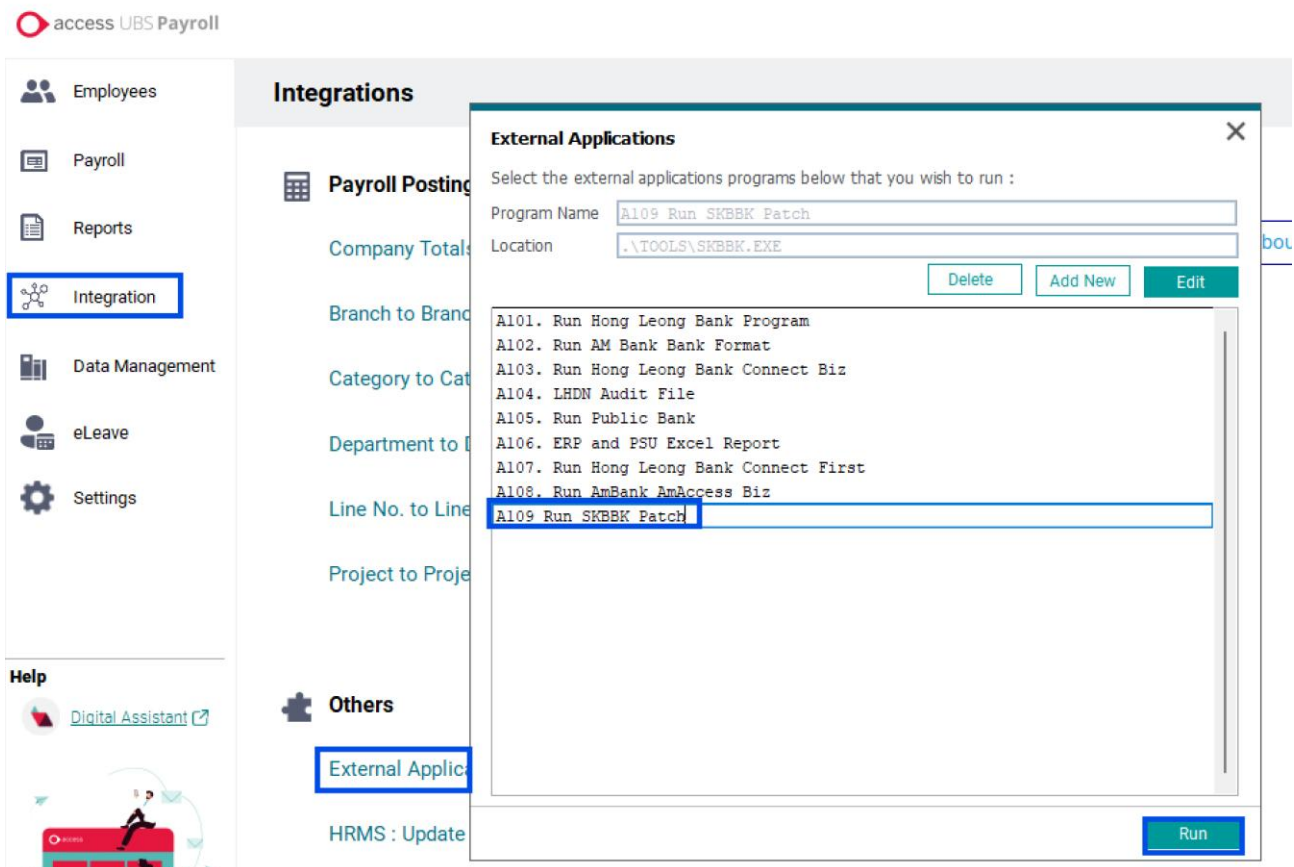

Run the SOCSO SKBBK Flag Patch

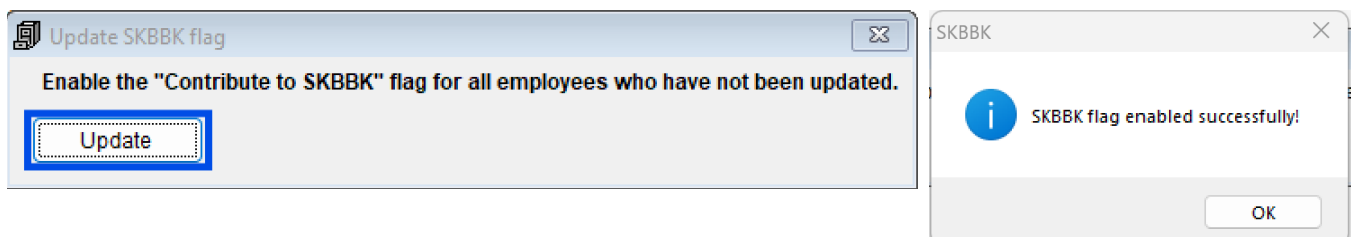
Reminder:

1. The patch only updates employees whose Contribute to SKBBK flag has never been saved. If the user has previously saved the Contribute to SKBBK flag — whether ticked or unticked — the patch will not modify it, to avoid overwriting the user's input.
2. Please backup your data before running the patch.

1. Open Access UBS Payroll and select the company you wish to update.
2. Go to Integration > Others section, click on External Applications.
3. Select A109. Run SKBBK Patch. Click on the Run button.



4. On click, the patch programme will update the Contribute to SKBBK flag = ticked for employees whose flag has not yet been saved, if any. A confirmation message will display upon completion.



5. Click OK to close the message.

Verify the Result

1. Go to Employees > select any existing employee > View Employee > Statutory Info tab > SOCSO Info section.
2. Confirm that the Contribute to SKBBK checkbox is ticked for affected employees.

Note: any employee whose flag was already manually set before the patch run (ticked or unticked) will retain that previous state.

3. Repeat for a few sample employees to confirm.
4. Re-run Process Pay for the affected pay period. The SKBBK contribution will now be calculated per PERKESO Lampiran 1 contribution table and reflected in the payslip and SOCSO statutory reports.
5. For employees who fall under PERKESO Scenario 26/27 (employee chose another employer to deduct SKBBK), manually open the employee record and untick the Contribute to SKBBK checkbox, then save.
