Terms of Use

1. The Garden of Angels refers to the designated area within Tao Fong Shan Christian Cemetery for the interment of miscarried fetuses of less than 24 weeks' gestation. Use of the Garden of Angels shall be governed by the Regulations of Tao Fong Shan Christian Cemetery and shall be subject to the standard charges prescribed by the Management Committee of Tao Fong Shan Christian Cemetery.
2. No individual burial plot within the Garden of Angels is designated for the interment of any particular miscarried foetus. The relevant area within the Garden may be reused for the interment of other miscarried fetuses after a period of not less than five years.
3. The receptacle used for the interment of a miscarried foetus must be made of organic and biodegradable materials. Metal, stone, plastic or any other non-biodegradable material is prohibited. Tao Fong Shan Christian Cemetery shall have the right to remove any material that has not fully decomposed when the interment location is reused. The dimensions of the receptacle shall not exceed 300 mm (diameter) x 200 mm (height).
4. Only the remains of one miscarried foetus may be interred under each application.
5. If, at or before 7:05 a.m. on the day of interment, the Hong Kong Observatory issues a Red Rainstorm Warning Signal, Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or any more severe weather warning, the interment service scheduled for that day shall be automatically cancelled without additional charge. The Applicant will be contacted to arrange a new interment time. Except where postponement is necessitated by the aforesaid weather conditions, the Applicant must notify this Office at least one week in advance of any request for postponement, failing which the Applicant shall be deemed to have forfeited the scheduled service. An additional administration fee of HK\$2,500 shall be charged for rescheduling the interment service.

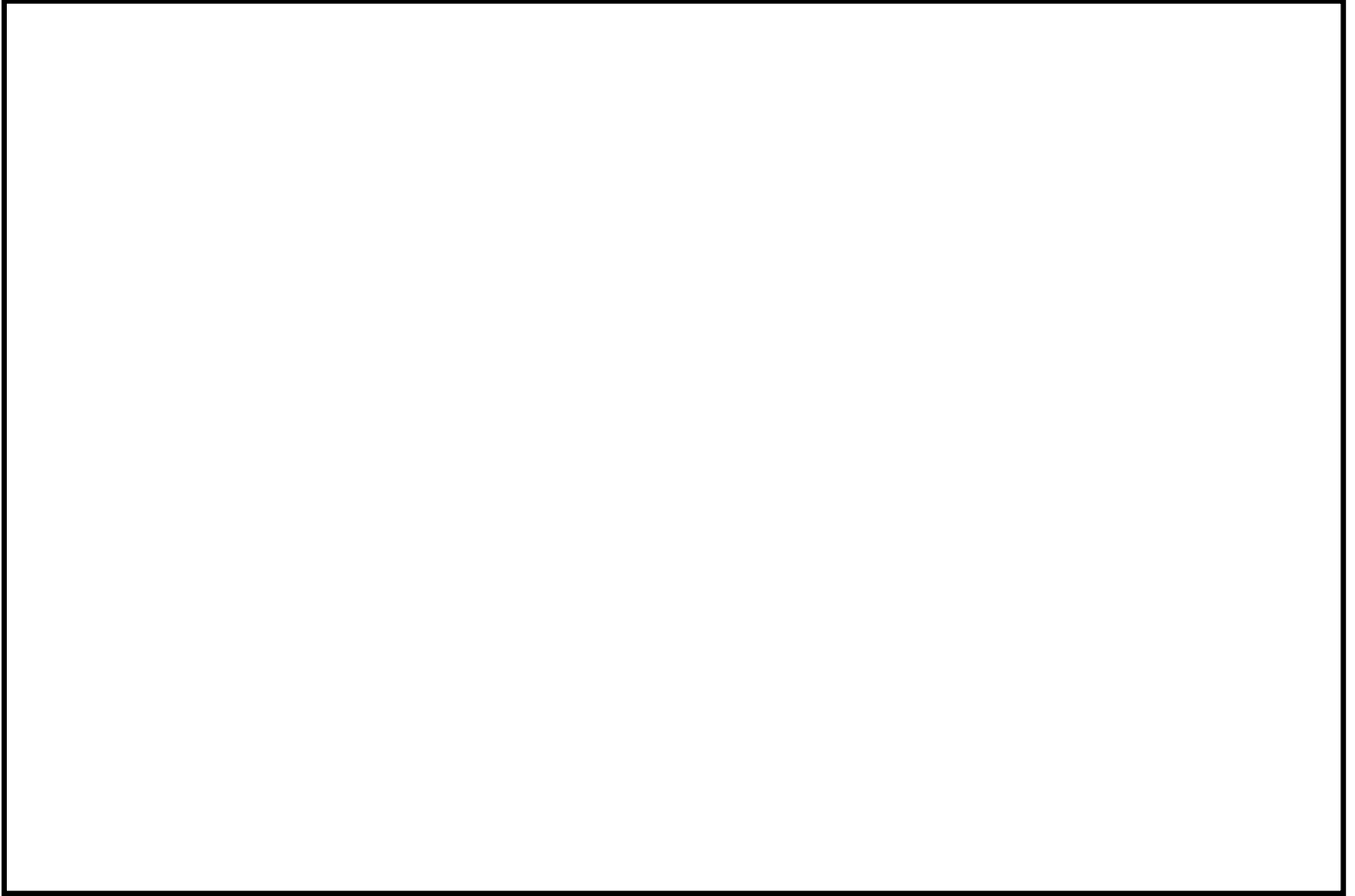

Submission of Application

1. The Applicant may submit the duly completed Application Form, together with copies of the required documents, to the office of Tao Fong Shan Garden of Angels in person, by post or by other means.
2. The Applicant may also submit the duly completed Application Form and copies of the required documents by email (goa@tfsc.org). (The originals of the aforesaid documents must subsequently be presented for verification by staff at the interview.)
3. The Applicant must attend this Office in person and present the original identity document for identity verification. The Cemetery will issue a confirmation letter to the Applicant on the spot for the purpose of applying to the hospital for the release of the miscarried foetus.
