

Fusing Campus Student Dormitory Living Rules

To maintain the dormitory environment, safety, and good quality, Dorm Residents are requested to strictly adhere to the following dormitory-related agreements during their stay (one academic year). Any violations will be penalized by filling out a Violation Form, and points will be deducted on a cumulative basis. **If 10 points are accumulated, Dormitory will determine whether students will be forced to move out (without a refund of the deposit) and pay the semester's dormitory fee.** The dormitory fee will not be refunded for the next semester, and students will be disqualified from applying for dormitory for the next academic year. If any violations are recorded during the academic year, students will not be eligible to apply for dormitory for the next academic year.

1. Dormitory Access Rules

No.	Rules	Point Deduction
1	Visitors are strictly prohibited from entering the public areas and dormitories on the opposite-gender floor. Please register as a visitor at the Information Desk on the first floor of Building H (visitors of the opposite gender are not allowed). Registered visitors must leave before 10:00 PM. Students who are not residents of the dormitory are not permitted to stay overnight.	10
2	All main gate is equipped with a card swiping device. Dorm Residents must use their ID cards to enter and exit the dormitory. Not allowed to lend student ID cards, access cards, room cards, etc. to others for use in entering and exiting the dormitory. Not allowed to use other people's ID cards or make false registrations.	8
3	Dorm Residents, smart wearable devices, etc at will; student ID cards, room cards, and keys may not be copied ID cards and room card permissions may not be copied to electronic products (mobile phones, tablets at will. If they are damaged or lost, please go to the Fusing Campus Dormitory Service Center Office (1st Floor, Building G) to handle it.	5
4	During the gate control period of Fusing Campus (00:00-06:00), weekends, national holidays, and winter and summer vacations, students must swipe their ID cards at the gate to enter and exit. May not refuse to cooperate with the security guards, counselors, and student dormitory service team to verify and register their identities.	5

2. Dormitory Safety Rules

No.	Rules	Point Deduction
1	Dorm Residents who wants to change their assigned bed (e.g., from Bed No. 1 to Bed No. 2) must complete the procedure at the Dormitory Service Center, Fusing Campus (1st Floor, Building G). No bed may be privately transferred without approval, nor may any resident occupy a bed without authorization or exclude others from moving in.	10
2	Stealing, using or dealing drugs, fighting or gang-related activities, gambling, and smoking (including e-cigarettes) are strictly prohibited.	10
3	Any form of intimate behavior is strictly prohibited in the dormitory.	10
4	Prohibited to engage in illegal activities online, violate academic network regulations, or spread false rumors.	10
5	Prohibited to carry or store dangerous items, engage in other illegal activities, damage public property (in addition to compensation at the price, points will be deducted for violations).	10
6	Dorm Residents are not allowed to take photos or videos in common areas or bathrooms, nor share photos or videos of other residents without permission.	10
7	ID card, access cards, and room keys must be kept properly and not be left in public areas.	6
8	Drinking alcohol, playing mahjong (including bringing in or mailing mahjong sets and tables), making loud noises, or engaging in indecent behavior such as nudity are not allowed in public areas.	5
9	Dorm Residents shall not bring fireworks, firecrackers, air guns, campfire or barbecue equipment, etc. into the dormitory. Activities such as lighting campfires, barbecuing, or any conduct that may endanger the safety of the dormitory area are strictly prohibited.	5
10	Prohibited to enter the rooftop of the Fusing campus or climb the walls (doors and windows) without permission.	5

11	Do not use or relocate surveillance equipment, interfere with emergency exits, or activate emergency alarm buttons without reason within the Fusing Campus.	5
12	Dorm Residents shall not infringe upon or disclose the privacy of roommates, including recording, filming, photographing, video calling, or live streaming without consent. No students may use another roommate's personal belongings or electronic devices without permission.	5
13	Dorm Residents shall not purchase, bring, mail, or use any fire-related devices, large appliances, low-frequency noise devices, or high-power electrical appliances (e.g., air purifiers, robotic vacuum cleaners), except hair dryers . For items of uncertain eligibility, residents must ask the dormitory service desk or the Dormitory Service Center at Fusing Campus. Any prohibited appliances be discovered, the Dormitory Service Team or the staff shall take custody of such items, and residents shall not refuse compliance.	3
14	Dorm residents are not allowed to use kitchenware or appliances (such as induction cookers, electric pots, rice cookers, kettles, etc.) to cook food outside the pantry or simple kitchen areas. Residents must also follow all rules for using the cooking areas.	3
15	Personal items such as shoes, trash, umbrellas, raincoats, bicycles, sundries, electric scooters, etc. are not allowed in hallways, lobby areas, stairwells, pantries, kitchens, laundry areas, or other non-permitted areas. Bicycles are only allowed in bicycle parking areas.	4
16	When entering or exiting the Fusing Campus, cars, motorbikes, and bicycles must enter through the main entrance and exit through the back door. Do not drive in the opposite direction or at random within the campus.	3

3.Dormitory Tranquility

No.	Rules	Point Deduction
1	From 10:00PM to 8:00AM are quiet hour, No noisy activities at the dormitory and public area. Please refrain from loitering in public spaces between 12:00 AM and 6:00 AM.	5
2	No pet allowed in dormitory including feeding strays	5
3	Political, religious or commercial activities are not allowed in the dormitory area without permission.	3

4.Room and Public Area Maintain

No.	Rules	Point Deduction
1	No smoking (included e- cigarette) at the dormitory and no cigarette end are allowed in the rooms.	10
2	Do not throw instant noodles, tissues, sanitary pads, paper scraps, fruit peels, food waste, or similar items into toilets, water dispensers, sinks, washbasins, or drains. If any blockage is caused, the Dorm Resident must cover the repair and cleaning costs.	5
3	Trash must be sorted for recycling first and disposed of at the designated garbage and recycling areas in the Fusing Campus during the assigned hours. Not allowed to leave trash in hallways, stairwells, or dorm rooms, or to discard it in public areas.	5
4	Not allowed to hang clothes, bed sheets, or place personal items in dormitory public areas such as lounges, balconies, or parking lots. Any items left for more than 3 days will be treated as abandoned and disposed of.	5
5	Keep the Fusing campus and room clean, maintain all equipment, and do not move or replace them at will.	3
6	Do not post pictures, posters, brochures, flags, etc. inside or outside the Fusing campus or dormitories to avoid damaging the walls.	3
7	Do not urinate or defecate in areas other than the toilet.	3
8	Do not alter or write on the whiteboards or door plates in the Fusing Campus without permission.	3

5.Other

No.	Rules	Point Deduction
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1	To Maintain the environment of Dormitory, Counselors and Dormitory service team have the right to visit dormitories and inspect facilities, and resident may not refuse.	10
2	When dormitory equipment needs to maintain or inspect, Maintenance personnel, Counselors and Dormitory service team may enter the dormitory, and residents should cooperate.	
3	Residents who, after moving into the dormitory, subsequently withdraw from or take leave from the university shall complete the dormitory check-out inspection at the dormitory service desk within 7 days following the completion of the withdrawal or leave procedures.	
4	After completing the payment and receiving the receipt, please go to the service desk to reissue the room card within 2 weeks . If it exceeds two weeks, you will need to do one hour of volunteer work .	
5	Volunteer hours must be completed within one month. Overdue hours must be made up the following month, plus one additional hour as a punishment. If volunteer hours are not completed by the end of the semester, NT\$300 will be deducted from the deposit for each hour missed.
