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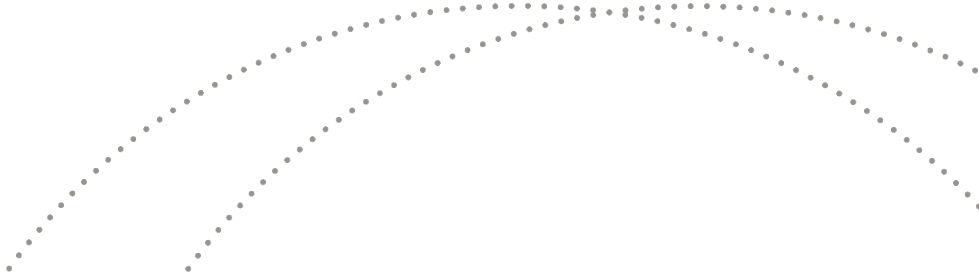

Blessed with a perfect subtropical climate and an average of eight hours of sun per day, Brisbane is the ideal destination for life in the great outdoors.



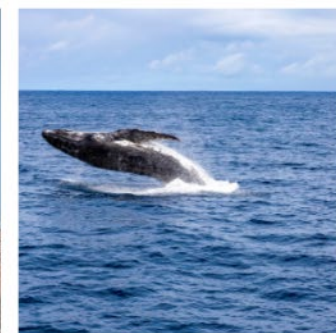

- UQ St Lucia, Herston and Dutton Park campuses are serviced by extensive public transport networks offering fast and reliable transportation

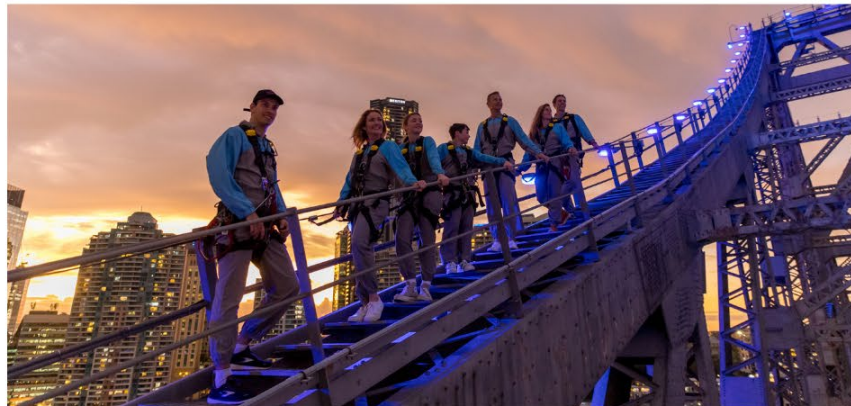

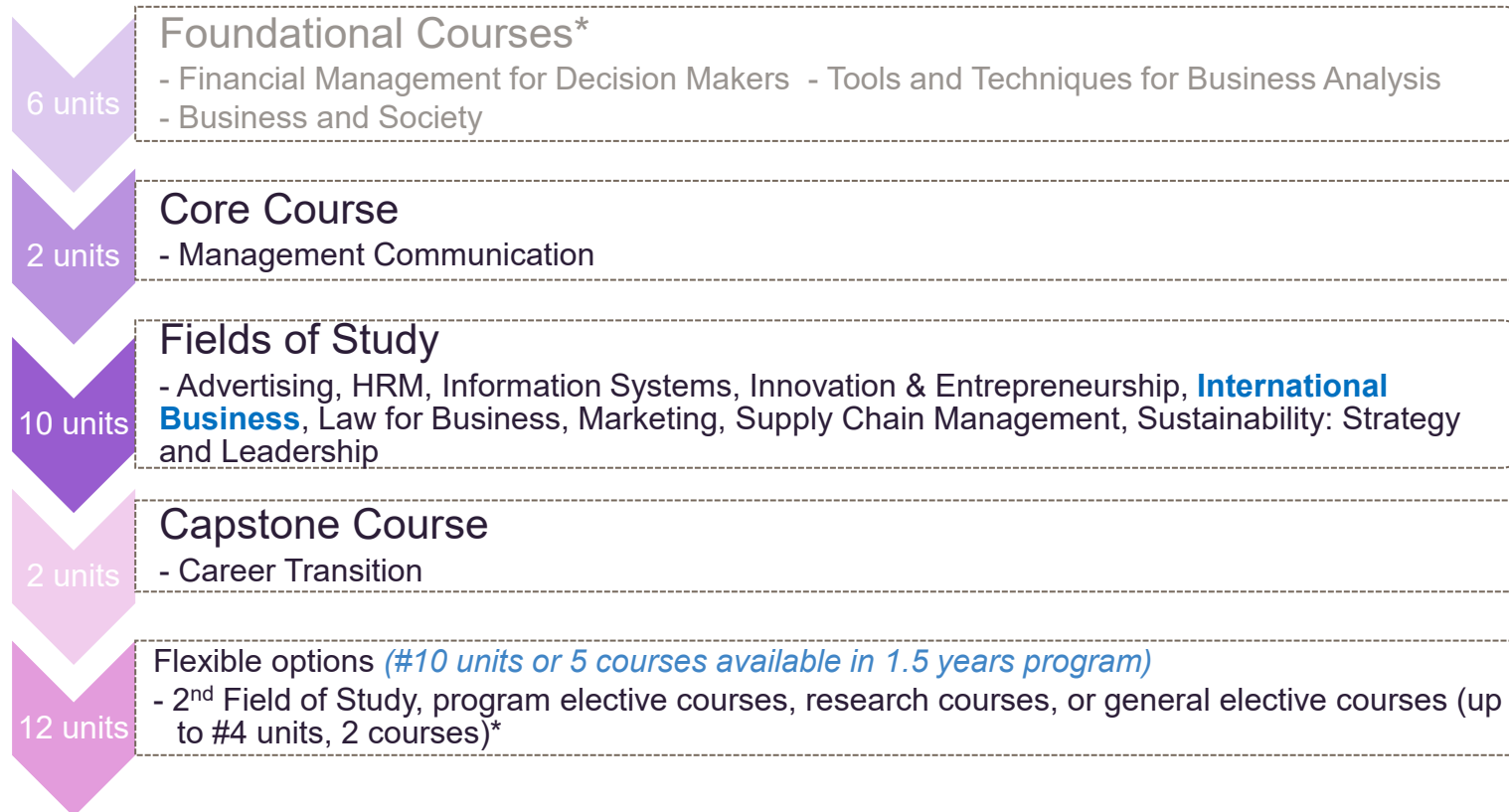

<i>Students with the bachelor degree NOT from the relevant discipline are required to complete the 8 recognized courses for the maximum half of the credit of a standard two (2) years Mbus program including at least one (1) maximum two (2) IB FoS courses and remaining courses from MBus Program Elective Course and a maximum of two courses towards MBus General Electives.</i>	

- Students shall not transfer more than half of the required units/courses in that field of study i.e. #4 units or two courses in the International Business field of study in the Master of Business to be awarded that FoS or major in Master of Business.
- Courses were assessed in September 2023 and will be reassessed every three years.
- Credit can only be granted for those courses that achieve a passing grade.

ENTRY & PRE-REQUISITES

Commencement at UQ

Semester 1 (February), or Semester 2 (July) each year

Academic entry requirements

- Overall GPA equivalent to 4.5 on a UQ 7-point scale (4 is a pass) (67/100, 60=pass, 100 is a full mark) of the Bachelor degree
- Have successfully completed one (1) year of the relevant Master study at FCU

English Language Proficiency requirements

- Medium of Instruction (MOI) fully taught and assessed in English in FCU English Taught Program can be considered to meet the English entry requirement for the UQ program (UQ's English Language Proficiency Admission Procedure (<https://policies.uq.edu.au/document/view-current.php?id=231>)). OR
- IELTS: overall 6.5 (6.0 in all sub-bands) or TOEFL iBT: overall score 87, Writing score of 21 & Reading, Speaking and Listening scores of 19)

UQ Online Applications

- **Copy of passport (biodata page)**
- **Prepare certified academic transcript & ask for application voucher code with departmental contact points**
 - Bachelor degree award & academic transcript
 - Master's program transcript (at least one semester)
 - Enrolment record or Letter of Enrolment of all courses including most recently enrolled in current semester
- **Evidence you have met English language requirements**
 - Certified Medium of Instruction (MOI) Letter signed by FCU Registrar OR
 - Copy of the IELTS/TOEFL Test Result

Closing dates

- Semester 1 (Feb): End of September of the previous year
- Semester 2 (July): End of February of the same year

UQ GLOBAL CONNECT SCHOLARSHIP

Award Value

- 25 per cent of tuition fee reduction for eligible FCU students who commence an approved credit transfer pathway at UQ

Eligibility

- meet UQ program entry requirements
- agree to the Scholarship terms and conditions
- commence studies in UQ's Faculty of Business, Economics and Law via an approved credit transfer pathway
- not hold any other UQ scholarship

How to apply

FCU provides a list of eligible students to UQ for consideration. All students from FCU who meet the eligibility requirements will be automatically considered for the Global Connect Scholarship.



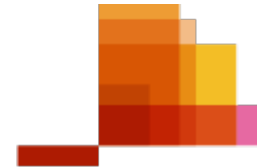
