Remarks: 1. Credit and miscellaneous fees for 18 credits are charged in advance for each semester of study, and 2 credit fees for physical education and military training courses are charged based on the number of hours attended. The actual credit fee is based on the number of credits taken on the deadline for course additions. If the student does not withdraw from the course before the deadline for course additions, the course credit fee will not be refunded (those who have not paid must still pay the credit fee). Additional payment or refund will be made at a later date after the deadline for course additions and withdrawals.

2. Inter-disciplinary (department) Credit Fee: The fee is calculated according to the higher level of the student's enrollment class and the elective class selected.

3. Students should pay the same amount of tuition and miscellaneous fees as day students during the period of study abroad.

If the student does not withdraw from the course before the deadline for course additions, the course credit fee will not be refunded (those who have not paid must still pay the credit fee). Additional payment or refund will be made at a later date after the deadline for course additions and withdrawals.
- 2.Except for the 10 credits required to make up the day-time Master's degree course in the Graduate Institute of Financial and Economic Law, which is charged according to the fee standard of the class chosen, all other courses are charged according to the fee standard of the department to which the student belongs.
- 3.Thesis and dissertation supervision fee is charged in the second semester of the first year: NT\$6,000 for the master's program and NT\$8,000 for the Ph.D. program.
- 4.For other miscellaneous fees, please refer to the other miscellaneous fees schedule.

III. Credit fees for summer courses

1. If the tuition and miscellaneous fees are charged under the full tuition and miscellaneous fee system, the summer credit fee will be calculated according to the standard fee of the selected class.
2. For master's and Ph.D. courses that are charged on a credit-fee basis, the fee is calculated according to the standard of the department to which the student belongs.
3. For courses with 0 credits for new graduates, a credit fee of 1 credit will be charged based on the user-pay principle.
4. Military training and physical education courses are still charged 2 credits in accordance with the regulations of the Ministry of Education.

IV. Extension Students

- A. The tuition and miscellaneous fees for extension students will be collected in two stages.
The first stage: Pay the miscellaneous fees and other miscellaneous fees before the deadline for payment of miscellaneous fees (for other miscellaneous fees, please refer to the other miscellaneous fee schedule).
The second stage: The credit fee will be calculated according to the number of course credits taken on the deadline for the course additions and the payment will be notified separately. Those who take 9 credits (inclusive) or less will pay the credit fee which is calculated according to the higher level of the student's enrollment class and the elective class selected. Those who take 10 credits (inclusive) or above will pay the full tuition and miscellaneous fees of the original department.
- B. The credit fee will be calculated according to the number of course credits taken on the deadline for the course additions. If the student does not withdraw from the course before the deadline for course additions, the course credit fee will not be refunded (those who have not paid must still pay the credit fee). Military training and physical education courses are charged 2 credits based on the number of hours attended per week.

1. 2 credits of physical education and military training courses will be charged according to the number of hours attended.
2. The adjustment of the tuition and miscellaneous fees for each academic year will be handled in accordance with the "Regulations for Charging Tuition and Miscellaneous Fees for Junior Colleges and Institutions of Higher Education".
3. Starting from the 2015 academic year, the tuition and miscellaneous fee standard for mainland and foreign students is 1.2 times that for domestic students (excluding overseas Chinese students).

4. After the deadline for course additions of this semester (2022.09.20), those who are only enrolled in external internship courses with a signed tripartite contract and no other courses (no course changes during the semester) may be refunded 20% of the miscellaneous fee at the end of the semester after the list is provided by the Registration and Curriculum Section.
5. Starting from July 1, 2021, Yuanta Bank will charge a 1.5% payment convenience fee for payment of tuition and miscellaneous fees by UnionPay cards.
6. Starting from the 2022 academic year, the insurance company will increase the student group insurance premium.
